## Registration

- 1 Please READ CAREFULLY the pricing details and dates regarding your chosen venue.
- 2 Students must be over 9 years of age.
- 3 Assistant Teachers must be over 16 years of age.
- 4 One-day registration is available on the first day of the workshop only.
- 5 For security purposes an **OBSERVER PASS** is required by all accompanying caregivers. **ONE FREE PASS** per registered student will be issued.  
On the day registrations will incur a fee. Observers are limited to **ONE BAG and ONE SMALL CHAIR** per person in order for us to retain the dance floor area.
- 6 Discounts for studio groups apply.
- 7 All dancers must wear ID bands at all times. The band must be in tact. Replacements will incur a charge.
- 8 Students under the age of 12 must have a responsible adult on site.
- 9 Phoenix management reserve the right to refuse service to any individual.
- 10 Confirmation of registration will be advised within 7 working days.

**DANCE WITH THE STARS:** This is a fabulous chance for dancers to perform with the faculty. Dancers are chosen during the second day of workshops to perform at the award ceremony.

**AWARDS REGISTRATION:** Pre Registered students and groups will receive their numbers in the packs from the registration desk.

Late entries should register at the desk on Saturday after 10.00am.

**CLASS LEVELS:** Three levels of workshops will run simultaneously at the event. To help in selecting a suitable level the following is a guide.

- **BEGINNERS** single pirouettes, jete, pas de bourree. (MUST BE OVER 9 YEARS OF AGE)
- **INTERMEDIATE** double pirouettes, chaine, pique, grande jete etc.
- **ADVANCED** triple turns, advanced jumps, fast tempo technique.

• **TEACHER and ASSISTANTS** this registration allows entry to any class and any closed teacher only workshops.
